REPORT FROM THE COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE

Purpose

To consider the report of the Compliance Committee.

Discussion

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 10-12 October 2013.

The Compliance Committee will be considering:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of compliance with CCSBT management measures.
- Action planned as part of the implementation of the CCSBT Compliance Plan. Items that the Compliance Committee will be considering includes:
 - Enhancement of CCSBT's Minimum Performance Requirements in relation to the Catch Documentation Scheme (CDS) and transshipments;
 - Consideration of an IUU vessel list;
 - Implementation of Port State Measures;
 - Results from CCSBT's Trial Quality Assurance Reviews (QARs) and recommendations for future reviews and other appropriate action;
 - Program of MCS assistance to Indonesia;
 - Any relevant research and development on technologies and tools to identify SBT (particularly once processed);
 - Enhanced monitoring through bilateral arrangements and international networks;
 - Consideration of any systematic monitoring and surveillance regimes that should be implemented; and
 - Identification and nomination of non-Member States whose cooperation should be sought.
- Review of CCSBT MCS measures.
- Discussion of new or enhanced MCS measures.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
