Report from the Compliance Committee

Purpose

To consider the report and recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

Discussion

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 9-11 October 2014.

The Compliance Committee will be considering a wide variety of matters, including:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of compliance with CCSBT management measures.
- Action planned as part of the implementation of the CCSBT Compliance Plan. Items that the Compliance Committee will be considering includes:
 - Enhanced monitoring through bilateral arrangements and international networks; and
 - Identification and nomination of non-Member States whose cooperation should be sought.
- Development of a new Compliance Action Plan for 2015-2017.
- Review of CCSBT MCS measures, including:
 - A Revised Transshipment Resolution;
 - Minor changes to the Catch Documentation System (CDS) and Authorised Vessel Resolutions;
 - A minor change to the IUU Vessel List Resolution;
 - An update of CCSBT's Minimum Performance Requirements;
 - Possible change to the Resolution on limited carry-forward of unfished allocations;
 - Quality Assurance Reviews; and
 - Review of publicly available trade data.
- Discussion of new and enhanced MCS measures, including:
 - Port State Measures;
 - Common Definition of the Attributable SBT Catch;
 - Consideration of concerns relating to an eCDS; and
 - Research & Development on new technologies to aid identification of SBT.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
