Report from the Compliance Committee

Purpose

To consider the report and recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

Discussion

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 8-10 October 2015.

The Compliance Committee will be considering a wide variety of matters, including:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of compliance of Members and Cooperating Non-Members (CNMs) with CCSBT management measures. The Compliance Committee may also recommend how instances of non-compliance should be addressed under the CCSBT's Corrective Action Policy.
- Action planned as part of the implementation of the CCSBT's Compliance Plan.
- Review and revision of CCSBT MCS measures with the intention of ensuring that these measures are operating effectively and efficiently and are updated as appropriate. The measures to be considered include aspects of:
 - Transshipment Resolution;
 - Catch Documentation Scheme (CDS), including a draft revision of the CDS;
 - Authorised vessels;
 - VMS;
 - Possible review of outdated resolutions;
 - Draft IUU Vessel List (if any vessels are nominated for listing);
 - CCSBT's Minimum Performance Requirements;
 - Quality Assurance Reviews; and
 - Review of publicly available trade data.
- Discussion of new and enhanced MCS measures, including:
 - Port State Measures; and
 - Research & Development on new technologies and tools to aid identification of SBT.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
