Report from the Compliance Committee

Purpose

To consider the report and recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

Background

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 5-7 October 2023.

The Compliance Committee will be considering a wide variety of matters, including:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of Members' compliance with CCSBT management measures.
- Notifications under Compliance Policy Guideline 5 (CPG5) and upcoming CPG5 review in 2024.
- Consideration of any actions required under the Corrective Actions Policy (CPG 3) and review of CPG3.
- Outcomes from the Technical Compliance Working Group (TCWG) in relation to compliance risks and proposed Compliance Action Plan (CAP) action items to address the identified risks aligning with the CCSBT's draft updated Strategic Plan.
- Outcomes from the EM/S workshop and High-Level EM/S Guiding Principles for CCSBT.
- Reports on any updates or problems with the operation of CCSBT's measures.
- Proposed revision to CCSBT resolutions including:
 - o Authorised Vessel Resolution; and
 - Transhipment Resolution (based on recent amendments that both ICCAT and IOTC made, and a proposal from Indonesia).
- Implementation of the CCSBT's Compliance Plan, including:
 - o Consideration of the future need for QARs.
 - o Update and discussion of Japan's Market Proposal.
 - o Standing items for which updated information may be available.
- Progress, budget and timeline toward the implementation of eCDS.
- Update on the project to enhance the implementation of seabird mitigation measures.
- The Compliance Committee's work program for 2024.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
