1. Dates

3. Submission and exchange of meeting documents

The Secretariat would like to propose the following timeline;

- > Preliminary list of Participants and list of Documents should be submitted to the Secretariat by 20 May 2025 (6 weeks before the meeting);
- ➤ Documents should be submitted to the Secretariat by <u>3 June 2025 (4 weeks before</u> the meeting).

Papers submitted after the due date will not be provided with an opportunity for a presentation at the meeting for the purpose of making up for the paper's lateness. Late papers will only be presented if requested by other Members, or if the paper is a key paper that requires presentation at the meeting regardless of when it was submitted.

6. Daily timeframe of the meeting
