Report from the Compliance Committee

Purpose

To consider the report and recommendations of the Compliance Committee.

Discussion

The independent Chair of the Compliance Committee will present the report of the Compliance Committee's meeting, which is to be held from 6-8 October 2016.

The Compliance Committee will be considering a wide variety of matters, including:

- Reports from the Secretariat and Members on compliance related matters and an assessment of compliance of Members and Cooperating Non-Members (CNMs) with CCSBT management measures. The Compliance Committee may also recommend how instances of non-compliance should be addressed under the CCSBT's Corrective Action Policy.
- Action planned as part of the implementation of the CCSBT's Compliance Plan.
- Review and revision of CCSBT MCS measures with the intention of ensuring that these measures are operating effectively and efficiently and are updated as appropriate. The measures to be considered include aspects of:
 - The Corrective Actions Policy;
 - Catch Documentation Scheme (CDS), including a draft revision of the CDS;
 - Authorised vessels;
 - VMS;
 - Transshipment Resolution, including a potential transshipment MoU with the WCPFC;
 - Possible review of outdated resolutions;
 - Draft IUU Vessel List;
 - CCSBT's Minimum Performance Requirements;
 - Quality Assurance Reviews; and
 - Review of trade data, including outcomes of the CCSBT funded project to determine the presence of SBT products in China.
- Discussion of new and enhanced MCS measures.

Recommendations may be made on these matters, which will require the attention of the Extended Commission.
